

Preschool Catechism with Proofs

Instructions to parents or leaders:

- 1) Gather kids together either at table or on the mats and tell them you are going to have a question/answer time.
- 2) Tell them you are going to ask this question, (give question) and they need to answer with this answer (give answer). "I say (question) and you say (answer)"
- 3) Make it fun. Do the question and answer at least three times in a row right then.
- 4) Next read to them the Scripture references that prove the question and answer are right
- 5) Review all past question/answers before you ask the new ones

1st Week

Question: Who made you?

Answer: God

Read: Psalm 100:3; Genesis 1:27

2nd Week

Question: What else did God make?

Answer: God made all things.

Read Acts 17:25; Colossians 1:16; Psalm 33:6-7

3rd Week

Question: Why did God make you and all things?

Answer: For His own glory.

Read Acts 17:26-27; Revelation 4:11; Psalm 19:1; Isaiah 43:7

4th Week

Question: How can you glorify God?

Answer: By loving Him and doing what He commands.

Read; John 14:15, John 6:29; Matthew 5:16

5th Week

Question: Why should you glorify God?

Answer: Because He made me and takes care of me.

Read: Psalm 23; Psalm 139:13-16

6th Week

Question: Are there more gods than one?

Answer: There is only one God.

Read: Deuteronomy 6:4; Isaiah 44:6; Isaiah 45:5; Ephesians 4:5-6

7th Week

Question: In how many persons does God exist?

Answer: In three persons.

Read: Genesis 1:26; Isaiah 6:8; John 14:23-26

8th Week

Question: What are the three persons of God?

Answer: The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

Read: Matthew 28:19

9th Week

Question: What is God?

Answer: God is a spirit, and has not a body like men.

Read: John 4:24

(This might bring a question about Jesus having a body. If it does share John 1:1-14 with them, and share how this truth makes what Jesus did so very special!)

10th Week

Question: Where is God?

Answer: God is everywhere.

Read: Psalm 139:7-12

11th Week

Question: Can you see God?

Answer: No; I cannot see God, but He always sees me.

Read: Hebrews 4:13; Jeremiah 16:17; Proverbs 15:3

12th Week

Question: Does God know all things?

Answer: Yes; nothing can be hid from God.

Read: John 16:30; John 21:17; Daniel 2:22

13th Week

Question: Can God do all things?

Answer: Yes; God can do all His holy will.

Read: Job 42:2; Matthew 19:26; Jeremiah 32:17

14 Week

Question: Where do you learn how to love and obey God?

Answer: In the Bible alone.

Read: Deuteronomy 6:4-9; 2 Timothy 3:16; 1 John 5:3

15th Week

Question: Who wrote the Bible?

Answer: Chosen men who wrote by the inspiration of the Holy Spirit.

Read: John 20:31-31; John 21:24; 2 Peter 1:21; Hebrews 1:1

16th Week

Question: Who were our first parents?

Answer: Adam and Eve.

Read: Genesis 3:20, Malachi 2:10, Act 17:26

17th Week

Question: Of what were our first parents made?

Answer: God made the body of Adam out of the ground, and formed Eve from the body of Adam.

Read: Genesis 2:7 (just the first part of verse- rest will be covered next week), Genesis 2:15-24

18th Week

Question: What did God give Adam and Eve besides bodies?

Answer: He gave them souls that could never die.

Read: Genesis 2:7, 1 Corinthians 15:45, Daniel 12:2

19th Week

Question: In what condition did God make Adam and Eve?

Answer: He made them in His image and blessed them.

Read: Genesis 1:26-28

20th Week

Questions: What is a covenant?

Answer: An agreement between two or more persons.

Read: Genesis 6:17-19, Genesis 9:9-17

21st Week

Question: What covenant did God make with Adam?

Answer: The covenant of works.

Read: Genesis 2:15-17

22nd Week

Question: Did Adam keep the covenant of works?

Answer: No, he sinned against God.

Read: Genesis 3:6, Romans 5:12

23rd Week

Question: What is sin?

Answer: Sin is anything we say, think, or do that is against God's commands.

Read: Genesis 3:6, Romans 14:22-23, James 1:14-15, 1 John 2:16

24th Week

Question: What was the sin of our first parents?

Answer: They listened to and believed the serpent instead of God.

Read: Genesis 3:1-6, Romans 1:25

25th Week

Question: Who tempted them to this sin?

Answer: The devil tempted Eve and she gave the fruit to Adam

Read: 2 Corinthians 11:3, 1 Thessalonians 3:5

26th Week

Question: Did God leave all mankind to perish in sin?

Answer: No, God sent a redeemer

Read: Isaiah 54:8, Isaiah 59:20

27th Week

Question: Who is the Redeemer that God sent?

Answer: Jesus is our Redeemer

Read: Psalm 34:22, Colossians 2:13-14

28th Week

Question: How did Jesus become our Redeemer?

Answer: He left heaven and became a man without sin

Read: John 1:14, Philippians 2:6-7, Hebrews 2:14, Hebrews 7:25-26

29th Week

Question: How did Jesus redeem us?

Answer: He paid our sin debt

Read: Romans 6:23

30th Week

Question: How did Jesus pay our sin debt?

Answer: He died on the cross for our sin.

Read: 2 Corinthians 5:21, Ephesians 1:7, 1 Peter 1:18-18

31st Week

Question: How do we receive this redemption (our freedom from sin)?

Answer: Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ

Read: John 1:12, Acts 16:30-31, Romans 10:9

32nd Week

Question: Why would God send His Son to redeem us?

Answer: He loves us

Read: John 3:16, 1 John 4:9-10

33rd Week:

Question: What is included in this redemption?

Answer: Forgiveness of our sins and a new covenant with God

Read: Colossians 1:13-14, Luke 22:19-20, Hebrews 9:11-15

34th Week

Question: How do we know that we have sin?

Answer: God gave us the Ten Commandments to show us

Read: Romans 3:19-20

35th Week

Question: Where do we find God's Ten Commandments?

Answer: God's Ten Commandments can be found in the Old Testament

Read: Exodus 20:1-17, Deuteronomy 5:6-21

36th Week

Question: What is the first commandment?

Answer: You shall have no other gods before Me

Read: Exodus 20:3, Deuteronomy 10:17, Isaiah 42:8

37th Week

Question: What is the second commandment?

Answer: You shall not make for yourself an idol

Read: Exodus 20:4, Isaiah 44:9-20, Romans 1:25

38th Week

Question: What is the third commandment?

Answer: You shall not take the name of the Lord in vain

Read: Exodus 20:7, Leviticus 22:32, Psalm 145:21, Acts 4:12

39th Week

Question: What is the fourth commandment?

Answer: Remember the Sabbath day and keep it holy

Read: Exodus 20:8, Matthew 12:8, Hebrews 4:9-10

40th Week

Question: What is the fifth commandment?

Answer: Honor your father and your mother

Read: Exodus 20:12, Proverbs 6:20, Ephesians 6:1-3, Colossians 3:20

41st Week

Question: What is the sixth commandment?

Answer: You shall not murder

Read: Exodus 20:13, Matthew 5:21-22

42nd Week

Question: What is the seventh commandment?

Answer: You shall not commit adultery

Read: Exodus 20:14, Matthew 5:27-30

43rd Week

Question: What is the eighth commandment?

Answer: You shall not steal

Read: Exodus 20:15, John 10:10, Matthew 6:19-21

44th Week

Question: What is the ninth commandment?

Answer: You shall not bear false witness

Read: Exodus 20:16, John 8:44, 1 John 2:3-6, 1 John 3:22

45th Week

Question: What is the tenth commandment?

Answer: You shall not covet

Read: Exodus 20:17, Philippians 4:11-12, James 4:1-3

46th Week

Question: Can anyone keep these Ten Commandments perfectly?

Answer: No, only Jesus could keep them perfectly

Read: Psalm 14:2-3, Romans 3:23, 2 Corinthians 5:21, 1 Peter 2:21-22

47th Week

Question: Did Jesus come to do away with the Ten Commandments?

Answer: No Jesus came to fulfill the Law and the Prophets

Read: Matthew 5:17-19, 1 Peter 1:24-25

48th Week

Question: How does Jesus fulfill the Law and the Prophets?

Answer: He took on flesh, lived and suffered without sin, died, and rose again.

Read: Luke 24:44-53, Hebrews 2:14-18

49th Week

Question: Where is Jesus today?

Answer: In heaven with the Father, praying for us, waiting to return

Read: Acts 1:6-11, Hebrews 4:14, 1 John 2:1

50th Week

Question: When will Jesus return?

Answer: We do not know the exact time, but Jesus gave us signs.

Read: Mark 13:32-36, 1 Thessalonians 4:14-17

51st Week

Question: What will happen when Jesus returns?

Answer: He will judge the world

Read: Acts 10:42, Acts 17:31, Romans 2:16, Revelation 19:11

52nd Week

Question: If we believe in Jesus what must we do until He returns

Answer: Love Him, obey Him, love others and tell them about Him

Read: John 14:23-24, John 15:12, Matthew 28:19-20, 1 John 2:28-3:3
