Pointer

Now the LORD said to Moses, "Come up to Me on the mountain and remain there, and I will give you the stone tablets with the law and the commandment which I have written for their instruction." (Exodus 24:12)

Please receive instruction from His mouth and establish His words in your heart. (Job 22:22)

Then He opens the ears of men, and seals their instruction (Job 33:16)

To know wisdom and instruction, To discern the sayings of understanding, To receive instruction in wise behavior, Righteousness, justice and equity; To give prudence to the naive, To the youth knowledge and discretion, A wise man will hear and increase in learning, And a man of understanding will acquire wise counsel, To understand a proverb and a figure, The words of the wise and their riddles. The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge; Fools despise wisdom and instruction.

(Proverbs 1:1-7)

Yet they did not listen or incline their ears, but stiffened their necks in order not to listen or take correction. (Jeremiah 17:23)

While Peter was still speaking these words, the Holy Spirit fell upon all those who were **listening** to the message. (Act 10:44)





## Pinky

Blessed be the LORD, who has given rest to His people Israel, according to all that He promised; not one word has failed of all His good promise, which He promised through Moses His servant. (1 Kings 8:56)

And we preach to you the good news of the promise made to the fathers, that God has fulfilled this *promise to* our children in that He raised up Jesus, as it is also written in the second Psalm, 'You ARE MY SON; TODAY I HAVE BEGOTTEN YOU. (Acts 13:33)

for the gifts and the calling of God are irrevocable. (Romans 11:29)

For when God made the promise to Abraham, since He could swear by no one greater, He swore by Himself, saying, "I WILL SURELY BLESS YOU AND I WILL SURELY MULTIPLY YOU." And so, having patiently waited, he obtained the promise. For men swear by one greater than themselves, and with them an oath given as confirmation is an end of every dispute. In the same way God, desiring even more to show to the heirs of the promise the unchangeableness of His purpose, interposed with an oath, so that by two unchangeable things in which it is impossible for God to lie, we who have taken refuge would have strong encouragement to take hold of the hope set before us. (Hebrews 6:13-18)
